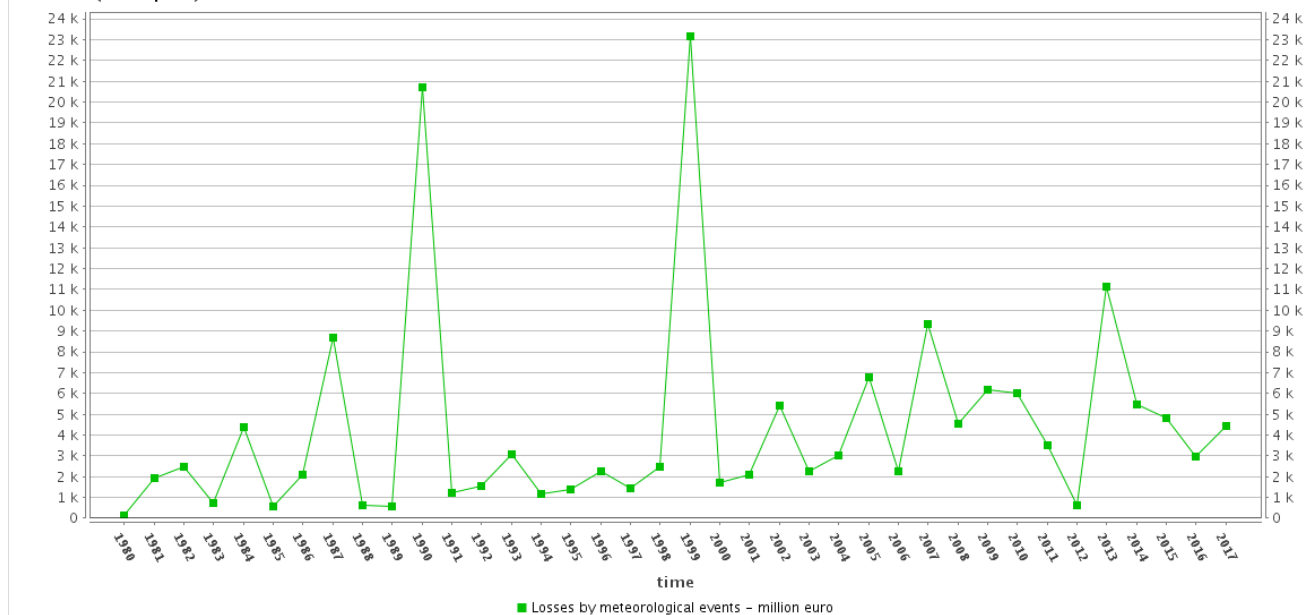


Climate related economic losses by type of event - EU aggregate (source: EEA)

Short Description: The indicator measures insured economic losses from weather and climate-related disasters expressed as economic losses per year in million euro (in current values). Types of disasters considered are hydrological, meteorological and climatological events. The indicator is based on data from the NatCatSERVICE managed by Munich Reinsurance Company. The NatCatSERVICE is a global database of natural catastrophe data around the world, collected since 1974.
